Board Updates

- There are still open positions on the board if you would like to contribute, please contact one of the board members.
- Parking at the south end you may have noticed the signs about fines is down. The permit parking plan is on hold but the expectation is that it will be raised again in sometime in the future due to the high number of trailers and cars at the south end
- Ambulance Service on the Lake management has moved from Temagami to the
 District of Nipissing Social Services Administration Board (DSSAB). The information we
 have received is that services will continue as they currently are. The concern is that we
 currently get paramedic services on the lake, paramedics have been picked up by boat
 to provide service at cottages. This is a unique service and not provided in other areas of
 Ontario. The board will continue to keep up to date if there are changes, we also
 included this question to the candidates for election.
- CALA will continue to support the Temagami Area Fish Involvement Program (TAFIP) and will provide a donation of \$1,000. This year.

Boat Livery
